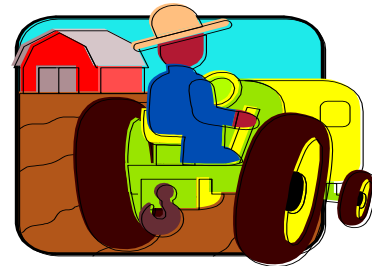


Migrant Education Program
