1. What time does school start and end?

Mary G. Hogsett Primary School begins at 7:35a.m. and ends at 3:05p.m.

Edna L. Toliver Intermediate School begins at 7:35a.m. and ends at 3:05p.m.

John W. Bate Middle School begins at 8:15a.m. and ends at 3:45p.m.

Danville High School begins at 8:15a.m. and ends at 3:45p.m.

2. How much is breakfast/lunch

All of our students can eat breakfast and lunch at no charge. High School students are also offered an after school snack at no charge.

3. How do I enroll my child in the Danville Independent School District?

4. Where can I go to access bus routes?

There are two waves of bus pickups. Primary and Intermediate students will be picked up in the first wave. After those students are dropped off, Middle and High School students will be picked up.

5. Can I visit my child at school?

Parents are always invited to eat breakfast or lunch with their child. Each teacher has different parent expectations for classroom parties/help and you will need to check with your child's teacher before coming to the classroom. Parents wanting to go on class field trips will need to have a completed background check. Background checks are done at Central Office (located at 115 E. Lexington Ave.)
