



Frequently Asked Questions

Danville Independent School Food Service

In order to promote transparency and better inform Danville stakeholders our district creates FAQs regarding topics that are of interest to the community, parents, students, and staff. Please see our website for additional FAQs on other topics.

1. Where do I find school lunch/breakfast menus?

School menus can be found on our website at <https://www.danvilleschools.net/Content2/24> Menus are also available in the school cafeteria by asking a cafeteria manager for a paper copy.

2. What is the cost for breakfast and lunch?

All meals are free. Danville participates in the Community Eligibility Program.

3. Why do I need to fill out a Household Information Form if all students eat free?

The information in the HIF form is vital for other school programs. Title 1 funds, funding for teachers, technology, grants etc. all rely on the data the form provides. Families only need to submit one form per household. The information is confidential and only personnel with a signed non-disclosure statement have access. Classroom teachers do not have access to the forms, only the aggregate numbers.

4. What do I do if my student has a food allergy?

You will need to submit documentation from a medical professional on the specific allergens and the recommended substitute. The nurse will communicate and enter the allergen on the point of sales system used at the school. This alerts the cashier to the allergen.

5. How are the Danville Schools Cafeterias Inspected?

The cafeterias are inspected by our local health department at least twice annually. The inspections are posted in the cafeterias. All Danville Cafeteria received 100% in their last inspection (February 2020).



6. What standards do the menus follow?

The menus follow the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs guidelines. The guidelines can be found on the USDA website. www.USDA.gov or the Kentucky Department of Education website under school and community nutrition (www.KDE.gov).

Professional Standards are required and up to date for all nutritional employees.

7. How much does it cost for an adult to eat lunch or breakfast and what are the lunch times?

The cost for an adult lunch is \$4.00 breakfast \$2.50.

Danville High School – Breakfast: 7:15-8:30. Lunch is divided into three periods (start time varies depending on the day of the week) M,W,F 11:40 -1:15 and T,TH 11:05-12:30.

J.W. Bate – Breakfast: 8:00 – 8:30. Lunch: 7th grade 11:15-11:44- 8th grade 11:44-12:13 6th grade 12:13-1:03.

Toliver Intermediate – Breakfast: 7:15-7:45. Lunch: 10:57- 12:42.

Hogsett Primary – Breakfast: 7:15-8:25. Lunch: 10:45 -12:15.
